Cancellation/No Show Policy

While the DRS understands that emergencies may occur, it is important that students make every attempt to notify the DRS office as soon as possible.

- If the instructor cancels a class it is the student's responsibility to notify DRS as soon as possible (within 24 hours, if possible).
- If the student knows he/she will miss a scheduled class, the student is responsible for notifying DRS as soon as possible (within 24 hours, if possible)
- If an emergency arises, the student is responsible for notifying DRS as soon as possible.

Failure to provide 24-hour notice may result in the following actions:

1. First occurrence – a letter or e-mail will be sent to the student reminding the student of policy and procedures related to interpreter services.
2. Second occurrence – a letter or e-mail will be sent advising the student he/she has failed to give 24-hour notice twice and that a third time may result in suspension of services until the student meets with DRS staff.
3. Interpreter services may be suspended with a letter or e-mail being sent to student who must then meet with DRS staff
