Admissions Information

- When is the deadline to apply?
 - CEI does not have an admission deadline
 - We recommend that students apply and submit all required documents early
 - This will allow time to process documents so students receive acceptance into CEI
 - o Students will receive notification from admissions through email and postal mail
 - Notifications will contain information on what the applicant is missing and/or their admission status

Cashier's Information

- How much is tuition?
 - o Per credit for the 20-21 school year
 - \$129 for Idaho residents (lived in Idaho at least 12 months)
 - \$258 for Non-Idaho residents
 - Additional Fees
 - \$15 Computer Lab fee
 - \$50 per credit not to exceed \$500 per semester for non-county residents
 - Students NOT living in Ada, Bonneville, Canyon, Jerome, Kootenai, or Twin Falls counties
 - Contact Assistant Registar with questions
 - Lab fees vary by course



• Where do I pick up my Financial Aid refund check?

- o The cashier's window in Bldg. 3
- o Remember to bring your valid government photo ID
- o First disbursement of checks for the term will be the Friday before classes start
 - Student will be notified via CEI email if they have a check available for pick up
- o Once the term starts, students who still have a check to pick up will need to complete a Verification of Attendance form
 - The form can be picked up at the Cashiers office
 - Students will need current instructors to sign the form verifying they have attended class

GED

- How do I get my GED?
 - Register and pay for the GED tests two different ways
 - Online www.ged.com
 - Call 1-877-392-6433
 - If you think you might need some help preparing, free GED prep classes are offered through our College & Career Readiness Center (CCR)

- How much does the GED cost?
 - o For all four tests − \$120 (\$30 per test)
 - You will pay with a credit or debit card when you schedule your exams

 - o Diploma Sender can email or mail the transcript to you
 - If you require your GED transcript for admission to a school, you must have the transcript sent directly to the institution from Diploma Sender, in order to be considered official

Registrar's Information

- Where do I get my official or unofficial transcripts?
 - o Student Affairs can print an unofficial copy of your transcript
 - Processing fee for Unofficial Transcripts are \$2
 - Fee is paid in the Cashiers Office
 - Current students can get an unofficial transcript from Self-Service
 - o If you need an official copy of your transcript, you can request it online through the CEI website
 - http://www.cei.edu/quick-links
 - Then click on Transcript Ordering (online)
 - The fee for official transcripts is \$10
 - Processing time for official transcirpts is 7-10 business days
- How do I receive financial assistance for the \$50 per credit fee, being an out of county student?
 - o Complete the District Residency form

 - Quick Links > Registrar > Center of page District Residency > click on Certificate of Residency Forms
 - Return form to your county clerk's office

 - → Applications should be done through Self-Service before deadline
 - Fee before deadline is \$15 fee
 - Fee can be paid online using Self-Service
 - o After deadline paper applications must be submitted

 - Fee after deadline is \$30
 - Fee is paid at the Cashiers office
