



Dave Facer has accepted the Foundation Executive Director at College of Eastern Idaho (CEI). Dave started his career at Children's Miracle Network (CMN) in Salt Lake City after his graduation from the University of Utah. Dave spent most of his time at CMN and building the annual event at university campuses across the nation called "Dance Marathon." In six short years, the marathon grew to more than 50 participating universities raising \$2 million per year, and he was responsible for all of CMN's collegiate activities.

Dave's next stop was BYU-Idaho in Rexburg where he took a fledgling corporate and foundation effort and built it into a program that raised \$4 million to \$5 million annually. He was a team leader and for four years led an organization of other team leaders to increase fund-raising policy, correlation, and a sense of esprit de corps within his department. Dave worked with individuals or major gift fund raising within assigned areas around the country.

Recently, Dave was at Intermountain Healthcare, focusing on fund-raising opportunities for the organization's non-profit hospitals in Utah County, Utah.

For more than 25 years, Dave has helped universities and other non-profits advance their missions through corporate, foundation and major gift fund raising, compassionate leadership, top-notch grant writing, portfolio management, building ties among competing departments, and raising nearly \$60 million in total. While each campus or cause is unique, every position throughout his career has involved starting from the bottom and building something that grows and blooms.
