## <u>Criteria for CARES Awards for Spring 2020 Enrollment Distribution:</u>

Distribution will include all students that were enrolled at least half time, six or more credits and demonstrate Title IV Eligibility. Students selected for awarding completed a FAFSA, had a valid EFC, demonstrate Title IV eligibility, making satisfactory academic progress, citizen or eligible non-citizen and degree-seeking with CEI for the Spring 2020 term.

Students that do not demonstrate Title IV eligibility at the time and are registered for 6 or more credits, may become eligible for this disbursement of funds. Students can apply for FAFSA and have it reviewed for Title IV eligibility or provide proof of all qualifications for Title IV eligibility. Grant amounts will range from \$200-400 for the enrollment groups.

## <u>Criteria for Emergency Funding Grant (COVID-19) Spring 2020 Distribution:</u>

CEI will use the remainder of the CARES Act Grant to assist students for Emergency Funding for Spring 2020. Students eligible must be enrolled at least half time, six or more credits and demonstrate Title IV eligibility. Students can request Emergency funds for food, housing, childcare, course material, distance based technology, and health care. Students will have the chance to demonstrate need for the 2020 year by filling out a simple application requesting emergency funding. The maximum funds we will award a student for need based CARES Act Emergency funding will not exceed \$1,000. We estimate funds will range from \$100-\$600 for emergency requests based on application, enrollment, needs & eligibility.

## **Students Exempt from CARES Grant award and Emergency funding:**

Dual-credit, early college, non-citizens, DACA students, in unsatisfactory academic standing, males required but not registered for selective service, students not Title IV eligible or unable to determine eligibility, incomplete FAFSA or missing items, students withdrawn from spring term, non-degree seeking, consortium students where CEI is not the home school, students registered for less than 6 credits, in default or an overpayment will not be eligible for CARES funding.
