Your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. Section	1-	<b>Family</b>	Size
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Write the names of all family members in the household <u>as of today</u>. Include age, relationship to the student, and college attending (if applicable).

The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other persons" align with the requirement that family size align with whom the student could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the student were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of completing the 2025-2026 FAFSA. As a result, the student should not include any unborn children in the family size.

#### Independent students, include the following:

- · You and your spouse, if married;
- Dependent children that will receive more than half or their support from you
- Other people if they now live with you, you provide more than half of their support, and you will continue to provide more than half their support from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

## Note: You are considered a **DEPENDENT** student if:

- You were born after January 1, 2002,
- You are not married at the beginning of the 2025-2026 school year
- You are not working on a master's or doctorate program,

- You are not currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces
- You do not have children or other people who receive more than half their support from you now and between July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026

### Dependent students, include the following:

- Yourself, even if you do not live with your parents
- Your parent(s) including biological, adoptive, and/or step-parent if applicable, even if you don't live with your parent(s).
- Your parent(s) other children if, your parent(s) will provide more than half of their support between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026 or the children would be required to provide parental information if they were completing a 2025-2026 FAFSA. Include children who meet either of these standards even if they do not live with your parent(s).
- Other people if they now live with your parent(s) AND your parent(s) provide more than half of their support AND will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2026.
