The Frontier CEI Scholarship Program creates opportunities for College of Eastern Idaho students pursuing programs in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM), helping them stay on track toward high-demand careers.

Incoming and current CEI students pursuing one of the eligible programs of interest, listed in Question 1 of this application, will be considered.

Priority will be given to students enrolled in programs that support workforce development or civic leadership, and who hold a CEI Spirit Card in good standing with Frontier Credit Union.

The application deadline for the 2026-27 academic year is April 15, 2026. Scholarship recipients will be announced early May 2026.
