Approved Volunteer Opportunities for Bonus Points

Dental & Oral Health–Focused Opportunities

- **Volunteering in any capacity at a community dental clinic**
- **Participating in free or low-cost dental events such as CEI Smiles, Give Kids a Smiles, or mobile dental clinics**
- **Volunteering at local dental offices in non-clinical roles (front desk assistance, filing, sterilization area organization)**
- **Helping with oral health education booths at health fairs or school events**
- **Providing oral health instruction in settings such as schools, assisted living centers, rehabilitation centers etc... (materials often provided) for any age range.**

Healthcare-Related Community Service

- **Volunteering in hospitals or medical centers**
- **Volunteering in nursing homes, assisted living facilities, or senior centers**
- **Supporting local public health departments with screenings or educational events**
- **Helping organizations that serve individuals with disabilities or special needs**

General Community Service Opportunities

- **Serving at homeless shelters, food banks, or community kitchens**
- **Volunteering at women's and children's shelters**
- **Participating in youth mentoring or after-school programs**
- **Joining community clean-up events or service days**
- **Helping run donation drives or organizing hygiene-supply collections**
