Meeting called to order at 4:05 by Fred A.

- Bailey mentioned that last week's minutes were uploaded into the Student Senate Teams folder at 1606hrs.

- Diamond mentioned that having a copy of the agenda available on the CEI website to show students what Student Senate proceedings look like.
- Hailey mentioned that the board of Trustee meetings are a great example of Roberts Rules and how those procedures look like and how they flow.
- Justin asked about when Board of Trustee meetings are held and volunteered to go to sit in more often, since his schedule opens more beginning in October.
- Luncheons with President Barber are still being worked on as far as scheduling, Fred will coordinate.
- Fred stated that Senate proceedings will follow the agenda; any other things brought up that is not on the agenda will be tabled until the next meeting.
- Hailey made a point of order that senate proceedings and agenda items must be done in items that relate to CEI, its students, and college business.
- Diamond asked about representation and looked for clarification from Hailey Mack about what we should and can do for the student body.
- Fred mentioned that we need to keep in mind that we represent the campus in both our student and personal lives and to act accordingly.
- Diamond asked for clarification on how to proceed with agendas and policies that may assist students at CEI or where these students could go to if

they have specific situations or qualms with those policies, Hailey Mack stated that CEI administration is there for its students and that administration is more than open to have sit-downs with students that have those concerns.
